- ❖ Maternity / Paternity leave and pay

- ❖ Generous defined contribution pension; master trust scheme operated by The People's Pension.
 - Moorfields Eye Charity (MEC) will make a contribution of 4% of salary to be matched by an employee contribution of 4% (the employee contribution attracts tax relief so you only pay 3.2%). In addition if the employee chooses to contribute a further 4%, MEC will make a further contribution of 4% (additional 3.2% after tax relief). There is a contracting out option in respect of your employment.
- ❖ 27 days annual leave days plus bank holidays
- ❖ On site staff restaurant (within Moorfields Eye Hospital)
- ❖ Interest-free annual travel season ticket loan (after three months and via Moorfields Eye Hospital)

- ❖ Liverpool Street Station is a fifteen minute walk and is served by the Central, Circle, Metropolitan and Hammersmith lines as well Greater Anglia and the Stansted Express.
- ❖ There are a number of buses that cover the city, north and central London.

- ❖ Moorfields Eye Charity is situated with easy access to the West End and all its shopping, Theatre and many cultural opportunities
- ❖ It is a short bus ride away from the Angel and Sadlers Wells Theatre
